





PADEL COURT



Padel (or tennis Padel) is a mix between tennis and squash, a racket sport that combines perfectly action with social interaction and fun.

Padel is played in doubles on an enclosed court made of glass and mesh and requires only half the surface area of a normal-sized tennis court.

It's an ideal game for all ages and abilities, as points are earned through strategy rather than strength and power.

Padel game rules:

- it is played only in doubles
- the scoring is identical to the one in tennis
- the service is executed by first letting the ball fall to the turf and then hitting it from below hip level
- you can help yourself by the glass walls to send the ball into the opponent's field
- the ball must touch the turf first before touching the glass walls

The game is easy to learn which makes it ideal for families as it can be easily played with mixed skill levels.





The required space for a PADEL court

If you are worried about the placement of a PADEL court, you can relax.

Being a sport for all ages, you can build the PADEL court near office buildings, schools, colleges, parks and shopping centers.

The padel court does not need a lot of space and usually has:

- 20 meters long
- 10 meters wide
- 3 meter high walls

A PADEL court is twice as small as a tennis court.









Types of PADEL courts



The Classic PADEL court

- the easiest padel arena to install
- has "frames" for each glass panel
- it is widely used in residential communities and private sports clubs looking for a low investment
- the glass is 10 mm thick



The Panoramic PADEL court

- top range
- ground without poles in the glazed area
- ensures good visibility for spectators watching the game from the stands
- the glass is 12 mm thick



Types of synthetic turf for a PADEL court

Eco synthetic grass

- Fibrillated type supports the natural bounce and trajectory of the ball
- It is a versatile, accessible lawn, used especially by padel or tennis enthusiasts
- The top layer of silicate sand matches the fibrillated texture of the ECO turf and significantly improves the match

Classic synthetic grass

- monofilament with straight threads gives a pleasant and quality appearance
- the fibers being harder, stay straight and slow the ball slightly




Pro synthetic grass

- Created from textured monofilament fibers, so popular lately
- After long research and development processes, textured monofilament fiber turf has become a favorite product, especially for its use on professional fields

PADEL Classic Court
